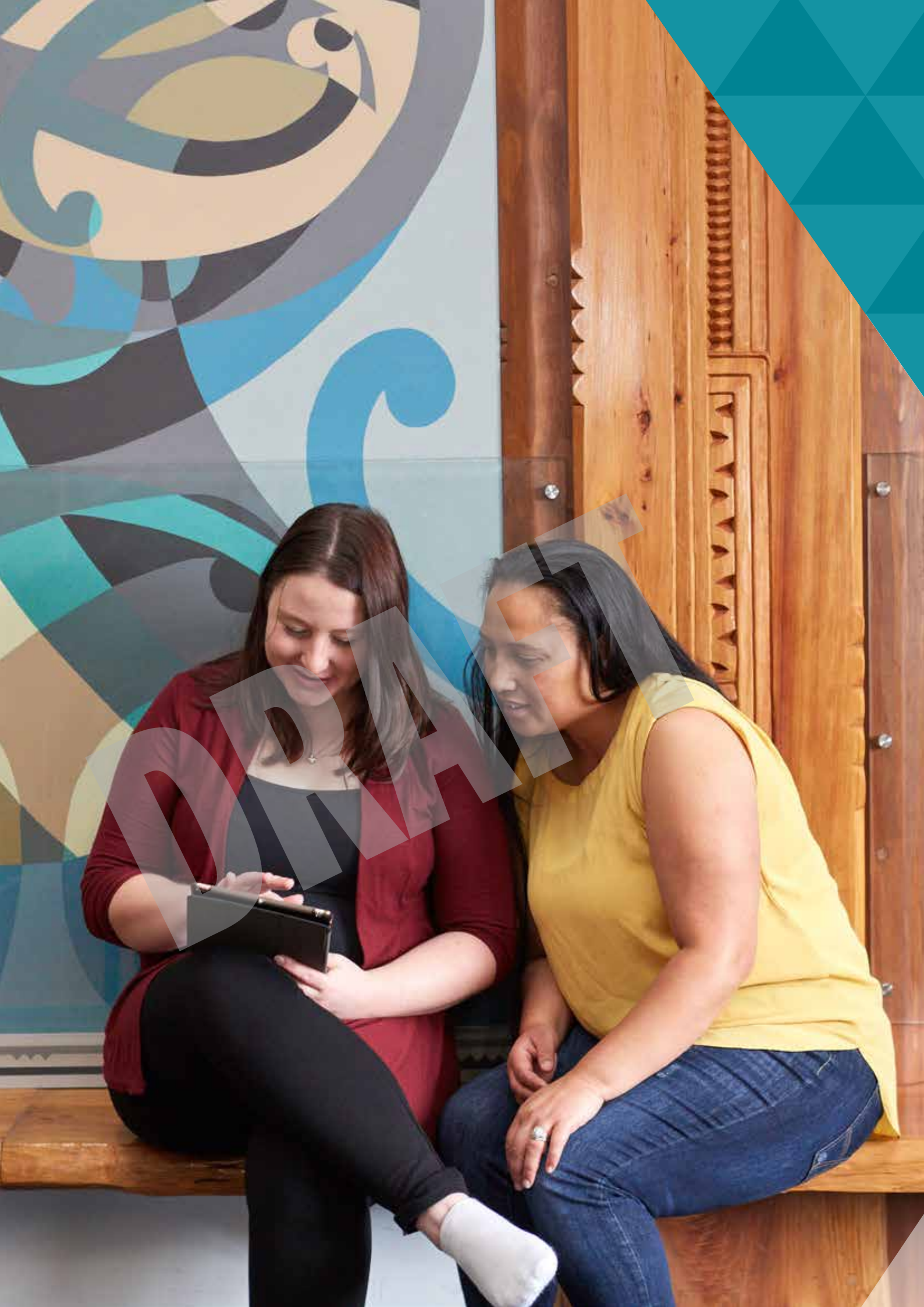

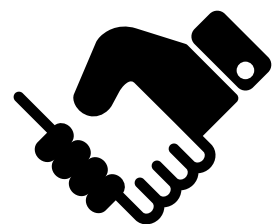

EDUCATION SYSTEM AND ENTRY CRITERIA

NorthTec's study programmes are designed to suit students with different levels of previous education, and varying life experience.

Certificates - Levels 2, 3 and 4

Certificates at NorthTec are usually at least 40 credits. They can take from 12 weeks to a full year to complete and can provide a pathway into diploma and degree programmes. This includes foundation level programmes. Most trades and service jobs require level 3 or 4 certificates.

Diplomas - Levels 5, 6 and 7

Diplomas take one to two years of full-time study and can lead to further study at degree level.

Degrees - Level 7

Degrees usually take three years of full-time study to complete and can lead to further study at master's degree or doctorate levels. A person who holds a bachelor's degree may be able to enrol for a post-graduate diploma or master's degree.

Graduate diplomas - Level 7

Graduate diplomas are qualifications at level 7. They are often one year of full-time study; a bachelor's degree or equivalent is the usual entry requirement.

Levels Each programme is classified by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) with a level from 1 to 10 on the New Zealand Qualifications Framework (NZQF). The higher the level, the more complex and demanding the programme.

Credits Credits show the 'value' of a programme and denote the length of time required to successfully complete it. One credit represents approximately 10 hours of study. 120 credits represent a one-year, full-time programme of study.

Entry guide

Each programme has entry criteria which must be met before you can enrol. The criteria will be related to prior achievement of certain academic qualifications or related to previous work, skills and experience. Students are also required to meet the English language entry criteria.

STUDYING IN WHANGĀREI

NorthTec's main campus is located in Whangārei, the largest city in the Northland region and one of the top holiday destinations in New Zealand because of its warm climate and natural beauty.



Whangārei boasts a sub-tropical climate, stunning coastline, relaxed lifestyle and relatively low cost of living.

The city is compact enough to make it relatively easy to get around by walking, cycling or using a local bus service.

Whangārei has a vibrant city life with a good variety of retail outlets, restaurants, bars and night clubs, as well as an active international community from Europe, the US and Canada, Asia and the Middle East.

Whangārei is only a two-hour drive from Auckland with a regular bus service providing a safe and cost-effective link between the two cities.

Translated from Māori, Whangārei means “cherished harbour” and is home to some of the country's most beautiful beaches on the Pacific coastline, from Bland Bay in the North to Langs Beach in the South.



APPLIED ARTS

NEW ZEALAND CERTIFICATE IN ARTS AND DESIGN

Tap into your creative skills and find out if studying the arts or design is right for you. This six-month programme will give you a great grounding in basic skills and techniques, working in a variety of media. You'll also learn about the history of art and design.

Courses making up this programme are Art and Design History, Creative Methodology, Visual Arts Studio and Graphic Design, giving you an opportunity to try your hand at different skills.

BACHELOR OF APPLIED ARTS

With majors in either visual or digital arts, this degree gives you the opportunity to explore a wide variety of approaches and techniques in the fields of drawing, intermedia, sculpture, ceramics, printmaking, photography, graphic design and digital arts.

It is distinctive in its emphasis on research-based practice, and the interdisciplinary connections that are developed throughout. Whilst exploring art and design theory and practice, there will be opportunities to work with our communities and to exhibit at our purpose-built gallery. You will be guided through the skills, work processes and professionalism essential to become creative, lateral-thinking problem solvers.

Your first year features core subjects: Art in History, Approaches to Drawing, Pacific Studies and Drawing and the Creative Process. Electives include: Sculpture, Clay/Glass, Printmaking – Intaglio, Photography (at) the Moment, Photography in Black and White, Graphic Design, Social Media in Practice, Interactive Design, Web Design, and Digital Graphics for Screen.

The second year core subjects, Issues in Contemporary Art and Design and Aotearoa Art and Design, combine theory and drawing practice so that art theory is embedded with hands-on making. Year 2 electives include: Photography in Context, Photography Viewfinder, Space and Materials, Studio Exploration - 3D Media, Intermedia, Printmaking Open Studio, Graphic Design, Sound and Moving Image, Digital Game Design, Mobile Device Technology, Animation and Motion Graphics.

The third year is based around preparing for the final exhibition, held at the Geoff Wilson Gallery. You will study core subjects and will gain industry experience, enabling you to find out more about the creative industries and preparing you to be a successful practitioner.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE

NEW ZEALAND CERTIFICATE IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE (LEVEL 2)

This qualification is intended for learners of English as an additional language, attending NZQA approved programmes delivered in Aotearoa New Zealand or off-shore. Graduates will have the language skills required to understand and use basic language in familiar situations to engage in simple and routine tasks, social encounters and exchanges of information with emerging fluency and accuracy.

Graduates will have the language skill required to communicate with independence and fluency in most situations and will be able to participate in everyday, workplace and academic English language contexts.

Year 1 incorporates the New Zealand Certificate in Cookery (Level 3 and Level 4). This will prepare you to work as a senior chef, including planning and producing a broad range of larder, meat, poultry and fish dishes, and developing and designing advanced dishes and menus.

Students who successfully complete the New Zealand Certificate in Cookery (Level 4) will also be eligible to apply to City and Guilds to be awarded the City and Guilds Diploma in Food Preparation and Cooking.

You'll gain a practical and theoretical knowledge of terrestrial and marine ecosystems, flora and fauna in New Zealand and learn about sustainability, environmental issues, monitoring and conservation techniques. You'll also get involved in the protection and restoration of local natural, rural and urban environments.

Cancellation and Refund Policy for International Students

FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS INCORPORATING THE CONDITIONS FOR TERMINATING ENROLMENT AND THE CONDITIONS FOR TERMINATING THE CONTRACT

Refunds of programme fees will only be made in accordance with the following policy:

By accepting a place in a programme of study at NorthTec, a student enters a contract with NorthTec for the period of one academic year (or the length of the programme if it is less than one year). This contract means there is an obligation to pay the fee for the year (or for the length of the shorter programme).

Students who wish to defer to the following semester must notify NorthTec International two weeks prior to the programme commencement.

There is no automatic right to a refund of fees if a student changes his/her mind about studying at NorthTec.

In normal circumstances, no refunds will be given after programme/course commencement. If a student decides to withdraw from a programme/course once enrolment has been finalised the student will need to complete a NorthTec Withdrawal Form which can be obtained from the International office.

Any request for a refund must be made in writing to the International Manager. The request must include a detailed explanation of the reasons for withdrawal from the programme/course. At this time, the student's family and agent will be notified by NorthTec that a request for refund has been received.

If a refund is given, it will be paid in NZ dollars and paid by direct credit either to:

- the original payer's nominated bank account, or
- if the Refund Authorisation Letter is completed by the original payer, to another party's bank account

Note: If the student is not the original payer, permission in writing from the original payer will need to be sought before the funds can be transferred to the student.

Consideration of Refund Applications

Applications for refunds will be considered under the following categories, which may require supporting documentation:

Full Refunds

- Immigration New Zealand (INZ) has refused to grant an initial visa for study in New Zealand
- Visa extension is refused by INZ
- NorthTec (Northland Polytechnic) is unable to proceed with the programme/course offered.
- If the programme contracted with NorthTec (Northland Polytechnic) is cancelled for whatever reason, then the student shall be entitled to a total refund of programme fees but shall not be entitled to any other compensation, costs or consequential damages of whatsoever nature.

Part Refunds

- An international student in a semester-based programme, who gains Permanent Residency will not receive a refund of fees for the semester in which residency is granted. However, they will be treated as a New Zealand Permanent Resident for the following semester and refunded any international fees paid beyond the semester in which residency was granted.
- International students in programmes designed with full year non-semester based courses must pay the international fees for the full year, regardless of the date Permanent Residence has been granted during that year.
- If a student wishes to withdraw their application, and notice is received by NorthTec International two weeks prior to course commencement, a cancellation fee of 45% of the tuition fee will be charged.
- Special circumstances of a compassionate nature, as approved by NorthTec, may necessitate withdrawal from a programme. Supporting information must be supplied in writing from the student, family and agent (if applicable).

No Refunds

- In the event of inadequate attendance and/or achievement resulting in the termination of enrolment and the contract, no refund is payable
- In the event of a disciplinary action resulting in the termination of enrolment and the contract, no refund is payable.
