Program Overview

You will study and live in Canada for approximately 16 months.

All concentrations include 12 prescribed courses completed over four academic terms. Each program starts in September or January.

Program Objective

Prepare you for leadership positions in the global business world by giving you the tools needed to rise to the top of your chosen industry.

The Master of Management program will:

- Enhance your knowledge of international accounting and finance
- Develop your core management and leadership skills
- Teach the necessity and value of marketing in the global business environment
- Improve your strategic, business knowledge
- Allow you to fully understand the role of a manager and leader
- Increase your quantitative knowledge and abilities

Program Characteristics

- Three courses per term (Monday to Friday classes)
- A fixed curriculum to learn business principles while focusing on your specialization
- Begin and end your studies with the same cohort of students
- Limited class size, and personal interaction with faculty
- Dedicated program administration staff
- An employment program to assist in developing your career portfolio
- Opportunities for employment after academic completion

The Master of Management

Master of Management program courses are conducted over four terms (approximately 16 months). You will take three courses each term for a total of 12 courses. While you will study your specialization of choice, you will also be equipped with core business courses with multi-disciplinary relevance and receive the practical knowledge required to excel. Employment Program

The Master of Management Employment Program, facilitated jointly by the Odette Career Services and the Centre of Executive and Professional Education, will guide you toward the development of your career portfolio to build the skills necessary to obtain employment.

The core of the program focuses on seven, dynamic workshops that occur during regular Master of Management studies:

Workshop 1: Skills Matching, Gap Analysis and Labour Market Assessment

Workshop 2: Resumé/CV and Cover Letter Development

Workshop 3: Orientation to Job Searching in Canada and for International Employment

Workshop 4: Immigration Legislation and Guidelines

Workshop 5: Interview Techniques and Effective Networking

In addition, you will be given unlimited access to one-on-one appointments with a career advisor. You will be encouraged to practise your interviewing skills using video play-back technology.

Admission Requirements

- Four-year, bachelor-level degree (or equivalent) in an acceptable discipline from an academic institution approved by the University of Windsor
- The equivalent of a 70% average or higher in undergraduate studies (when converted to Ontario standards)
- Demonstrated English proficiency by meeting or exceeding a 7.0 score in the IELTS test, or a TOEFL score of 100 (ibt)*
- Two supportive letters of reference (at least one from an academic source)

Enrolment is limited. Preference will be given to candidates who exceed the above minimum requirements and those with relevant work experience. Please visit our website for application instructions.

 - Official transcripts are required from all institutions you have attended
 - Translation is needed if the official copies are not in English
 - English language proficiency test score
- 3 Track your information

 - Student number (ID) and Personal Access Code (PAC) will be provided to you once your application has been received.
- 4 Accept your offer and pay your deposit
 - Accept your offer by scanning and returning your Acceptance Response Form by email: apply@uwindsor.ca
 - Payment information will be on your Letter of Offer
- 5 Apply for a study permit
 - If you are not a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, convention refugee or landed immigrant, you will need to obtain a Study Permit to study in Canada. Please visit www.cic.gc.ca
- 6 Register for Courses
 - Please follow instructions on your Letter of Offer or contact your Program Administrator
- 7 Pay your tuition
 - After selecting your courses, you must arrange to pay the final amount of your tuition in order to finalize your registration.
