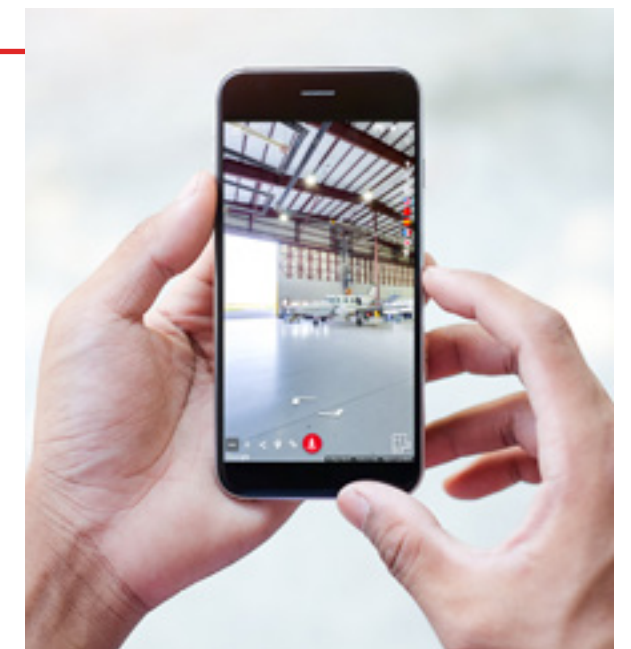
Did you know?

PAYING FOR YOUR CANADIAN EDUCATION



\$5+ MILLION dollars available in 650+ scholarships, awards and bursaries awarded every year.

Your education is a major investment and a major part of choosing where to study. That's why we try our best to provide support and resources to help you along the way. To get started, we've put together some yearly costs you'll need to consider to help you start planning now:

- ▶ Tuition and fees for international students typically range from CAD 16,000 to CAD 18,000*
- ▶ Other expenses to consider include textbooks, a computer, housing, food, entertainment, etc. that can range from CAD 10,000 to CAD 12,000**
- ▶ A London Transit bus pass is included for full-time London students in programs with classes on campus (blended format)

*Tuition fees vary by program, including some that are much higher (eg. Aviation programs, Renewable Energies, etc.) For actual fees by program, visit fanshawec.ca/international/fees.

Your FANCard is your official Fanshawe student identification card. But it does more than just act as ID – keep life simple and use it as your bus pass*, to access on-campus services and to pay for food, printing and more.

Save time and avoid line ups by uploading your photo online and completing the verification process to receive your FANCard before starting classes.



BUS PASS

A London Transit Commission bus pass is included within your program's fees for all full-time students in programs with classes on campus in London. Simply hop on a bus and tap your FANCard.

SERVICES & BUILDING ACCESS

Use your FANCard to access after-hours building entrances, computer labs and specialized program-specific facilities. Your card is also used to:

- ▶ Access the Student Wellness Centre at the London Campus
- ▶ Use media equipment and take out materials from the library
- ▶ Access services at the Test Centre

FLEX PLAN / MEAL PLAN

No need to carry cash, just load and use your FANCard. By logging in at fancard.fanshawec.ca purchases can be tracked online and unused balances can be carried over to the next academic year. Use your card for:

- ▶ Printing
- ▶ Photocopying
- ▶ General parking lots at the London Campus

Non-residence students: Load your Flex Plan at fancard.fanshawec.ca with as little as \$5 and use it for food, printing and retail purchases.

Residence students: Your mandatory Meal Plan starts at \$1,200 with the option to purchase additional amounts in-person throughout the year or you can add additional funds to a Flex Plan.
