Theological studies, along with religious studies, provides a unique perspective on our diverse world. The B.Th. helps you develop critical and analytical thinking, communication skills and an understanding of and respect for others. It examines critical topics such as ethics and justice as well as social policy and human dignity exploring the very basics of our humanity. It can be taken along with minors in other areas such as ethics, interfaith studies, entrepreneurship, or theology and Bible.

Of course, the Bachelor of Theology can also be a foundation for spiritual leadership within your own faith tradition, including ordination for ministry when taken with the appropriated graduate degree.
