



International Study Trip

Final year students participate in our annual international study trip as part of the mission course. At present, the ten-day trip is designed to engage students in dialogue with the Church in Cuba. Students visit various congregations, mission enterprises, and spend time at the Matanzas' Evangelical Theological Seminary in conversation with professors and students, while reflecting on the relationship between the gospel and culture.

Our Programs

The Presbyterian College offers the Master of Divinity degree as well as the Diploma in Ministry, the General Assembly Certificate and the Montreal School of Theology Certificate. Students wishing to explore some form of Christian ministry may enroll in Presbyterian College to receive degrees offered through McGill University including the B. Th., S.T.M., M.A., and Ph. D. The College also provides extensive opportunities for lay education and continuing education for church leaders.

Our History

Established in 1865, Presbyterian College is one of three colleges of the Presbyterian Church in Canada. We are also a member of the Montreal School of Theology, one of the oldest ecumenical educational consortiums in North America. The Presbyterian College is also accredited by the Association of Theological Schools and affiliated with McGill's School of Religious Studies.

Applying

Students apply directly to Presbyterian College as well as submitting a separate application to McGill's School of Religious Studies. Once accepted, an additional application can be made to the New Church Development and Congregational Renewal program, as a special stream within the M. Div. Students should also ensure that all denominational requirements are met as described on our website.

Tuition

We know student debt is a major concern for graduates going into ministry. At Presbyterian College, we have kept our tuition rates among the lowest in Canada. In addition to affordable fees, the College offers generous bursaries for PCC candidates. We also encourage our prospective students to explore student loan and grant opportunities since both Presbyterian College and McGill University are degree-granting institutions recognized by the Province of Quebec.

Core M. Div. Program

The Presbyterian College's core program is designed to nurture all elements of your leadership abilities. Here, you will form a strong theological foundation with an emphasis on biblical studies and will engage in opportunities to develop core skills in all areas of congregational life. Weekly chapel will center your studies in the worshipping community here at the College.

Congregational Experience

In your final year of studies, half your time will be spent working in a congregation with an experienced supervisor. Generally, this will be a congregation within your own denomination where you will have the opportunity to integrate theological studies with ministry skills and denominational traditions.

Mentoring

Following graduation, you'll have the opportunity to participate in an extensive mentoring program, which provides support, encouragement, and ongoing skill development as you navigate the early years of ministry. This unique program allows you to share your experiences in ministry with others through regular videoconference sessions and a yearly on-campus event, where you will be guided by Presbyterian College faculty and experienced ministers.

Congregational Renewal & New Church Development

Presbyterian College is presently developing a program in congregational renewal and new church development. Eligible students are provided bursaries to work in these unique settings for three months in the summer for a total of six months of specialized learning.
