Why Presbyterian College?

Our purpose is to equip leaders to live out their faith in the church and in the world. We work within an ecumenical context as part of the Montreal School of Theology, affiliated with McGill University's School of Religious Studies. At Presbyterian College, you will have the opportunity to integrate theological studies with spiritual formation, developing both character and competency to prepare for your vocation.

Our History

Established in 1865, Presbyterian College is a member of The Montreal School of Theology, accredited by the Association of Theological Schools and affiliated with McGill's School of Religious Studies. We belong to one of the oldest ecumenical educational consortiums in North America.

Why the S.T.M.?

Theological studies, along with religious studies, provides a unique perspective on our diverse world. The S.T.M. provides an advanced level of study in four possible areas:

- Asian religions
- Biblical studies
- Christian thought and history
- Religion and culture

The S.T.M. is a non-thesis degree but requires 12 credits in a research project in an area of interest to the student and approved by their advisor. Students taking the S.T.M. in the ordination track must have their course selection approved by Presbyterian College. Students may complete the S.T.M. in four semesters or one full 12-month year of study.

After the S.T.M.

Upon completion of the S.T. M., students may choose to do further advanced studies or to pursue ministry within their denomination. For those seeking ordination, the S. T. M. must be followed by the one-year In Ministry Program.

The diversity of study within the S.T.M. allows students to pursue different areas of study or work following the completion of the degree.
