During your year at emlyon business school, you will be integrated with the current students, representing various cultures and professional backgrounds, and have the chance be introduced to European business models through project based learning.

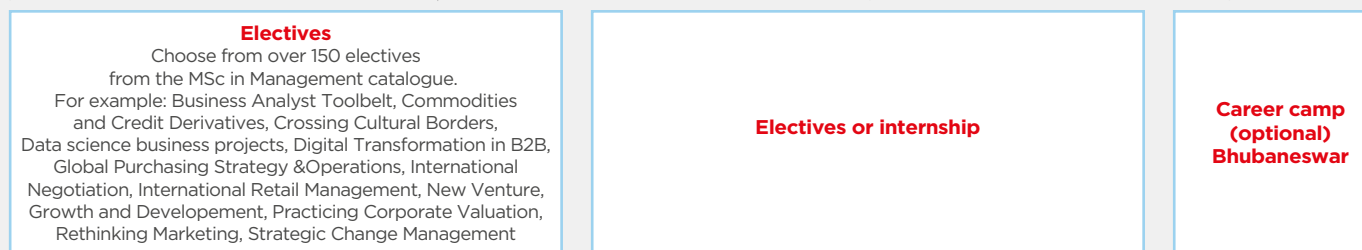

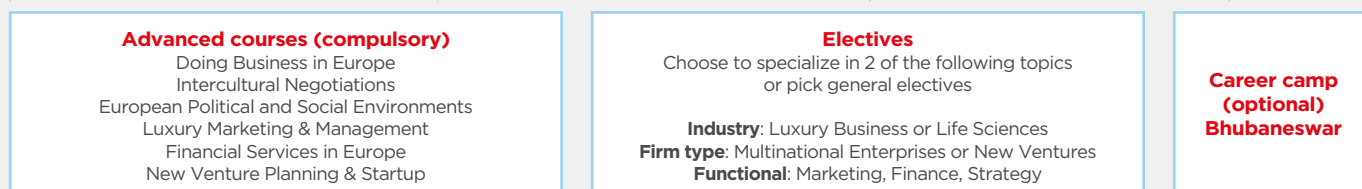
Program architecture MBA/MSc

2. Record your video

You are asked to record a video of yourself using the online platform easyRECrue.

Your video will be submitted to the jury directly.

The jury members will evaluate your video and send their feedback to the Admission Board. Should the jury have further questions, you may be asked for a face-to-face or Skype interview.

3. Admission Board

After filling out your online application and recording your video using easyRECrue, the Admission Board will review your application.

From then on, there are four possible outcomes:

- Admitted
- Admitted Under Condition
- You are invited to a face to face or Skype interview
- Non Admitted

Investing in tomorrow's entrepreneurial leaders

As a socially responsible organization, Xavier-EMLYON Business School provides a partial scholarship support fund to help qualifying students further their education. If a candidate of the Full-time Global MBA program falls under one of the guaranteed scholarship categories, the scholarship will be awarded after due consideration and review.

The scholarship will be provided after a specific financial aid request is made by the student. Then the student can complete the declaration of honor form and attach it with relevant proof to the application. The selection committee will then award scholarships according to the candidate's profile. Please note scholarships can be accumulated at the discretion of the XEBS management after due consideration and review.

Guaranteed scholarships

Excellence scholarship - up to 40%

- A scholarship of up to 40% will be granted to candidates with a GMAT score of over 600 or a CAT/XAT score over the 85 percentile

Alumni recommendation - 10%

- An additional 10% will be awarded if the candidate is recommended by an alumnus and alumna of an MBA program of Xavier University or emlyon business school. The candidate must know this alumnus either personally or professionally.

Non-Guaranteed Scholarships

First Indian State scholarship - 20%

- A scholarship of 20% is granted to the first participant of each state in India

Executive Woman Scholarship - 20%

- A scholarship of 20% is granted to women

Early Bird Scholarship - 20%

- A scholarship of 20% is granted to candidates who apply before the end of December 2019 for the 2020 intake

Scholarships are partial and under no circumstances imply a total tuition waiver

The business school's historical campus is situated in pleasant, rural surroundings just 15 minutes from the centre of Lyon in the town of Ecully. The buildings, located in a large 15-acre park, provide 30,000 m2 of office and teaching space. In line with the Business School's digitalization strategy, this space is under transformation, notably with the opening of the learning hub in 2015 and the 45/4 space. In 2016, the installation of the new incubator and makers' lab, in the heart of the campus, has created the first ever creativity & learning hub in Europe.
