Double degree program

(Application deadline: 1st of May)

Two years out of three in the engineering program leading to the national Master Degree in Engineering (in French: Diplôme d'Ingénieur).

Introduction week at Centrale Marseille

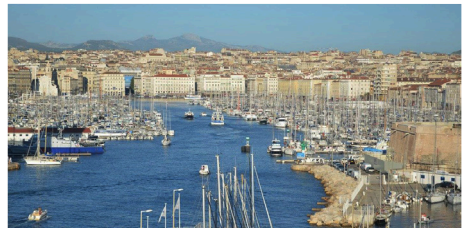
Intensive French language courses, social events and help to settle down, offered in August and in January.
