How You Will Learn

Expanding your knowledge and skills at Master's level is extremely fulfilling.

There are many routes into Postgraduate study. You may have just graduated from your undergraduate degree and are looking to specialise your knowledge and skills, or you may already be in employment and looking to advance your career with a promotion, or even change career direction. You may just be looking to fulfill a dream in a particular subject or topic.

Whatever your reason for being interested in Postgraduate study, RGU offers a study option to suit you, support your career ambitions and make you more employable.

Study Modes

The majority of our postgraduate courses start in September or January, although some courses have alternative start dates. Check course details from page 44 for more information.

Full-time On Campus

The quickest route and requires full attendance for the duration of the programme. Full-time on campus Master's courses nornally have a duration of 12 months. This study mode allows you to gain the knowledge and skills you require within the shortest amount of time.

Part-time On Campus

If you are looking to continue working during your studies or have other commitments, this options allows you to incorporate studying with other responsibilities. Part-time courses run alongside the full-time courses and split the same modules across the length of the course. Course duration is normally 2 or 3 years depending on what course you are interested in.

Online Learning

Online Learning is a fantastic study option if you are unable to study on campus. Our online learning courses are delivered through CampusMoodle, the University's Virtual Learning Environment. It is a valuable tool that provides an integrated package of resources and facilities to all of our students via the internet. You will be able to integrate with fellow students and tutors through innovative technologies including webinars, podcasts, online chats and discussion forums.

Continuing Professional Development (CPD)

Life-long learning is considered to be an integral part of personal development and Continuing Personal Development (CPD) is fundamental to the development of any career.

We offer a range of CPD modules which can contribute to your lifelong learning. We deliver these in a variety of learning modes – on campus and online, full-time or part-time.

The RGU Professional Studies framework (PSF) enables you to build up credits at a pace that suits you. You can study for one off modules or you can build up enough credits to reach an academic award.

Master's Degree (MSc/ MA/ LLM/ MBA)

Our Qualifications

Graduate Certificate (Grad Cert)

This is an access to Masters course. The award of a Graduate Certificate is equivalent to SVQ level 4/SCQF Level 9. For most subjects there will be three modules studied one at a time over one academic year. They will be assessed by a coursework assignment at the end of each module.

Postgraduate Certificate (PgCert)

This award is granted on completion of modules which accumulate to 60 credits.

Postgraduate Diploma (PgDip)

This award is granted on completion of modules that accumulate to 120 credits. If you complete a Diploma you will have accumulated 120 of the 180 credits you would need to gain a Master's degree.


Master's Degree (MSc/ MA/ LLM/ MBA)

The Master's award is granted on completion of modules that accumulate to 180 credits and typically includes a dissertation. This helps you to consolidate and apply the skills and knowledge gained in your earlier study.

Doctorate (PhD/PD)

A doctorate is a research driven thesis on your specific topic. It takes around 3 years full-time and 5 years part-time to complete. Application is normally to MSc/MRes with transfer to a PhD dependent on satisfactory progress around 12 months.





Your Finances

There are many ways to fund your study and it is worth considering all of your options. Plus, if you are an Alumni of RGU, we offer a healthy 20% discount on fees.

Payment instalment options are available, but how and when you pay is determined by factors such as where you live and your chosen mode of study. Further details can be found at **www.rgu.ac.uk/pgfees**



STUDENTS FROM SCOTLAND

Eligible Scottish domiciled students on an eligible full-time course can apply to SAAS for a tuition fee loan of up to \pm 5,500 and a living cost loan of up to \pm 4,500. If you study a two year full-time course these amounts will be split into each year of the course.

Part-time students can apply for a tuition fee loan of up to £5,500 for the course split across each year of their course. Courses should take no longer than twice the length of the full-time equivalent course. For example, one year full-time courses could attract two years of parttime support and two year full-time courses could attract four years of part-time support. One year full-time courses that have a part time option that take 3 years are not eligible. Part-time students are not eligible for a living cost loan.

STUDENTS FROM EU

Eligible EU students can apply to SAAS for a tuition fee loan as above. EU students are not eligible for a living cost loan.

STUDENTS FROM THE REST OF UK (RUK)

RUK students undertaking a full postgraduate Masters course may be able to apply for a Postgraduate Loan. Courses can be:

- full-time, lasting 1 or 2 academic years
- part-time, lasting 2 to 4 academic years but must not take more than twice the length of the equivalent full time course


These are all required to upload when you apply online.
