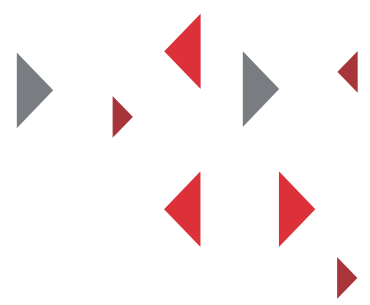

HOW TO APPLY



1. CHECK THAT YOU MEET THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Once you have decided on your programme, you will need to provide proof that you meet the entry requirements. Each programme has its own entry criteria based on academic achievements, qualifications and/or work experience. Check these online at www.manukau.ac.nz

Make your experience count

Get ahead in your career and fast track your qualification by acknowledging what you already know with Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).

RPL may be available to those who can prove competence through work experience, life experience, prior study or a combination of these. Fees may apply.



2. APPLY TO STUDY

You will need to supply:

- Your certified academic transcripts from high school or other education providers (in English)
- A copy of your passport
- Proof of meeting language requirements.



3. ACCEPT AND ENROL

If your application to study is successful you will be emailed an offer. This will include information on tuition fees, insurance fees, method of payment and a copy of the MIT refund policy.

To accept an Offer of Place you must provide the following documents to MIT International:

- Completed invoice and acceptance form
- Completed accommodation form.



4. APPLY FOR STUDENT VISA

#If you have completed the New Zealand Certificate in Hairdressing (Salon Support) (Level 3) your study duration will be 17 weeks. Your course fees can be provided upon application.
