

FURTHER INFORMATION

IMMIGRATION AND INSURANCE

This section contains important information about immigration, insurance and the policy governing international student welfare.

IMMIGRATION

New Zealand Immigration Service requires a student to have up to NZ\$20,000 in their bank account to cover living costs for one year of study, plus a return ticket to their home country.

Full details of visa requirements, advice on employment rights in New Zealand while studying, living costs and reporting requirements are available through the New Zealand Immigration Service and can be viewed on its website at www.immigration.govt.nz.

MEDICAL AND TRAVEL INSURANCE

International students must have appropriate and current medical and travel insurance from the time they leave home until the expiration of their student visa. EIT can organise insurance for you with our preferred provider Studentsafe Insurance (www.insurancesafenz. com/studentsafe) brought to you by Marsh/ Allianz. There is no insurance application paperwork to complete unless you have pre-existing medical conditions. Insurance fees are included in the invoice along with tuition fees. Students should contact our Registry team as soon as possible if they decide to organise their own insurance as all insurance policies must meet a minimum standard of care and cover for Immigration New Zealand and Code of Practice requirements.

Most international students are not entitled to publicly funded health services while in New Zealand. International students may be liable to pay the full costs of medical treatment in New Zealand. Full details on entitlements to publicly funded health services are available through the Ministry of Health and can be viewed on its website at www.moh.govt.nz. Students who do not choose EIT's insurance must show evidence of insurance prior to departure from their home country to be able to enrol.

ACCIDENT INSURANCE

The Accident Compensation Corporation (ACC) provides accident insurance for all New Zealand citizens, residents and temporary visitors to New Zealand, but visitors to New Zealand may still be liable for all other medical and related costs. Further information can be viewed on the ACC website at www.acc.co.nz.

CODE OF PRACTICE

EIT observes and is bound by the Education (Pastoral Care of Tertiary and International Learners) Code of Practice 2021 administered by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA). The Code is a document that provides a framework of outcomes for educational providers and their agents to deliver for their international students. The purpose of the Code is to ensure high-quality pastoral care is delivered to all tertiary and international learners studying at New Zealand institutes.

The Code provides both required outcomes for tertiary and international learners and key processes to support their well-being, achievement and rights. A student's application to study at EIT is the initiation of a contract with EIT. The Offer of Place issued to the student is EIT's acceptance of the contract. The payment of fees by the student indicates the student's acceptance of the contract.

EIT STUDENT VILLAGE NAPIER

The EIT Student Village (SV) is a self-catering complex of 12 villas housing six students in each, and on-site managers providing 24-hour support for resident students. The SV is located opposite the EIT Napier campus, next to the Sports Centre and bus stop.

Students will be required to pay a one-off \$400 deposit plus 10 weeks' rent in advance and sign a contract with the SV for a minimum of one semester (20 weeks).

HOMESTAY

We strongly recommend English language students apply for homestay accommodation. Our homestay families provide a warm and welcoming environment by giving students their own room and food for meals. They offer students the opportunity to assimilate into the New Zealand way of life by becoming part of a local family. All of our homestay families are carefully selected and supervised. They have been vetted by police and EIT staff.

FLATTING

The Flats on York and Gloucester are self-catering complexes of 11 units with 2 bedrooms in each flat. These are ideal for students who want flexibility and independence, or those with partners.

BOARDING ACCOMMODATION

Students are welcome to arrange their own private accommodation. Rent ranges from \$150-\$250 per week depending on the location and if utilities are included. Please check the accommodation information, which will be sent to students who are accepted to study with us at EIT.

GISBORNE

Students can choose to stay with a homestay family or in private accommodation. Please note: There is no Student Village complex on our Gisborne campus.



AUCKLAND

The International Student Support Team is the main support for all international students before they arrive and once they are on-campus and living in New Zealand.

The International Student Support Team is available for all questions, concerns or troubles, providing confidential and non-judgemental support, including a 24-7 emergency contact person.

Support is available for information on banking, driving in New Zealand, sexual health, homesickness and culture shock, travel in New Zealand and insurance – basically any question students may have about study and life in New Zealand.

The International Student Support Team also provides an accommodation placement service.

Academic Mentors are available to support and assist international students in their studies. At the start of the semester, students will meet an International Mentor who will support them with any academic issues throughout the year.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT PEER MENTORS AND REPRESENTATIVES

International students are also further supported by our student Peer Mentors and Student Representatives at the Napier and Auckland campuses.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ENROLMENT OFFICERS

Our Enrolment Officers provide dedicated support to EIT students through the process of student visa extensions, variation of conditions for work and study and poststudy work visas. Students can contact an International Student Enrolment Officer at visas@eit.ac.nz.

Academic Learning Services assist students throughout their study by providing free oneon-one support; for example, in regards to study planning, computing, academic writing, learning, exam techniques and mathematical and study skills.

Disability Support Services and a Chaplaincy Team are also available if students require further support.

EIT provides free one-to-one counselling on employment in New Zealand. Our specialised Careers Counsellors will help students in the following ways:

- Develop skills and knowledge to plan and manage their careers
- Provide information relating to the job market
- Provide information on job search strategies
- Assist with the preparation of job applications, including assisting with writing a CV and covering letter and completing online job applications
- Develop interview techniques

EIT also has a dedicated Industry Partnerships Manager based at our Auckland campus. The Industry Partnerships Manager works closely with students to enhance their employability through interactive workshops, specialised employment coaching, visits to workplaces and providing in-depth industry research support.

EIT offers a **free** essential academic skills course to assist students transition into graduate level study. This is available at the start of your programme.

Key skills covered:

- Academic integrity
- Research skills, paraphrasing and referencing
- Critical reading, evaluation and analysis
- Team work
- Written and oral communication

The course is delivered across disciplines. It provides a great opportunity to meet students on other programmes, both domestic and international.

Evidence shows that students who have taken this course find it easier to transition to the New Zealand learning environment and achieve greater academic success.

TUITION FEES

Our programme tuition fees are outlined with the corresponding programme information on pages 5 and 7. The tuition fees listed are for programmes starting in 2022.

Please note:

- The tuition fees listed are annual fees unless otherwise stated.
- If a programme of study is less than one year's duration, the tuition fee listed for that programme is the tuition fee for the whole programme.
- Tuition fees include Goods and Services Tax (GST).
- Some programmes may have additional course-related costs. Please check individual programme information on our website for course-related costs not included in the tuition fees.
- English Language additional costs: e.g. IELTS exam entry fees.
- International tuition fees are reviewed each year. If a student is accepted into a programme of study that is longer than one year in duration, the fees in the second and subsequent years will not be known when the student first applies and enrols. There may be a slight increase.
- EIT reserves the right to increase tuition fees for the subsequent semester/year. We aim to inform students what the tuition fees for subsequent years are prior to enrolment for their subsequent semester/year.

Disclaimer: The programme fees, other costs, entry requirements, duration and programme start dates are for 2022 and are listed as a guide only. All fees shown in the prospectus are in New Zealand dollars and include Goods and Services Tax (GST) at current rates. Programme content is based on current information and may be subject to change. EIT reserves the right to cancel or postpone any programme and shall not be liable for any claim other than that proportion of the programme fee which the cancelled or postponed portion bears.

OTHER FEES STUDENT SERVICES LEVY

All students also pay a Student Services Levy. This covers student services provided to all EIT students, such as sport, recreation and cultural activities, student advocacy etc. The Student Services Levy is \$345.00 for the full academic year.

Students who are only studying for a portion of an academic year will be charged the Student Services Levy on a pro-rata basis. The Student Services Levy will be identified in your invoice.

TEXTBOOKS AND STATIONERY

Textbooks and stationery may be required for specific programmes. If required, students will receive a textbook list once they enrol in their courses and depending on the programme, textbooks can cost between \$500 and \$1,000 per semester. For programmes that do not require students to purchase any specific textbooks, New Zealand-specific content will be provided on the online study platform, EIT Online.

LIVING COSTS

The cost of living in Napier and Gisborne is generally cheaper than the larger cities in New Zealand. Students will need to budget their weekly expenses. Students may spend more or less depending on their individual circumstances, but EIT staff members are also available to assist with budgeting information. It may take some time to secure a part-time job (if students are eligible to work in New Zealand), therefore it is important for students to have enough funds to cover living expenses for several months.

FREE FOR OUR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- Airport pickup from Napier or Gisborne (depending on campus of study). This service is for international students who move into homestay or other EIT arranged accommodation.
- Orientation programmes are run at key entry points and are mandatory for all newly enrolling international students.
- Social events are scheduled throughout the academic year.
- Employment workshops are provided by the Career Development Service to help students find work.
- Our team provides placement in EITmanaged accommodation for those students who apply for this service.
- No application fee.

Your course selection form will be sent to you by our team. After completing your course selection form, you will be sent an invoice. You can then pay your fees by bank transfer to EIT's account. Full account details and payment information will be provided, on your invoice.
