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

ACCOMMODATION

As soon as you've received an offer of a place to study, you can apply for your accommodation.

We guarantee a room on campus for all international students. Living on campus is safe, convenient and great for your social life. You'll be close to lectures, the libraries and entertainment, and will save money on transport too. There are also shops and laundry facilities on site. What more could you need?

You can choose to live on either College Lane or de Havilland campus, regardless of where you're studying. Both campuses offer a great mix of accommodation, all with Wi-Fi.

Inside our halls are individual flats for six to 12 students, with a choice of single or double bedrooms. These are either ensuite or have shared bathrooms.

You'll share a kitchen but have your own food locker. There are also some single studio rooms, separate to the flats, with their own kitchen and bathroom.

You can apply for accommodation to live on campus for 42 or 50 weeks. As an international student we advise that you apply for a 50-week contract so you can have a room during the summer term. Options are available if you're studying with Hertfordshire International College or on Pre-sessional English courses.

WHAT ARE YOUR FUTURE CAREER PLANS / AMBITIONS?



ACCOMMODATION

It's vital that you book and secure your accommodation before you arrive in the UK to start your course.

TRAVELLING TO THE UK

The UK welcomes overseas students, however, immigration control can be rigorous and there are sometimes delays at the airport when you arrive. You can help by keeping all of your important documents together and in your hand luggage. Be prepared to answer questions about where you are staying, and why you have come to the UK. The Border Force Officer must also be satisfied that you speak English at the required level without the need for an interpreter. You may also be fingerprinted if you supplied biometrics for your visa application.

Most major airlines will fly into either
Heathrow or Gatwick Airports. The University
offers a free collection service to students
travelling to Heathrow on certain dates for
January to September. You need to book your
place in advance. The University is in Hatfield,
Hertfordshire, 25 minutes by train from central
London. The nearest train station is Hatfield

(direct route from King's Cross Station). The University is a short taxi journey or bus ride from Hatfield railway station.

IMMIGRATION AND VISA

Most international (non-European Economic Area – EEA) students need a visa / entry clearance to study in the UK. You can self-assess online at the UK Government's Home Office website to see if this is relevant to you. EEA nationals don't need a visa or entry clearance to study in the UK. If you're an EEA national you can travel into the UK using your passport or national identity card.

ORIENTATION WEEK

To help you settle into life at the University, we run a free Overseas Students' Orientation Programme (OSOP). The programme has been designed to familiarise you with all aspects of living and studying in the UK. It'll give you all the advice and information you need to make the most of our time in the country and at the University.

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FEES & SCHOLARSHIPS

Like every other UK university, we charge tuition fees for our courses. These are different for UK, EU and international students. Our standard tuition fees are based on fulltime courses taught on campus.

INTERNATIONAL UNDERGRADUATE FEES

Our standard tuition fees for courses starting in 2019 are £12,350 per year for all standard courses, both classroom based and laboratory / workshop based.

INTERNATIONAL TAUGHT POSTGRADUATE FEES

Our standard tuition fees for courses starting in 2019 are £12,650 per year for all standard courses, both classroom based and laboratory / workshop based.

INTERNATIONAL POSTGRADUATE RESEARCH FEES

Our research tuition fees can be found on our website.

EU UNDERGRADUATE FEES

Our standard tuition fees for EU students for courses starting in 2018 are £9,250 per year for full-time undergraduate study.

EU POSTGRADUATE STUDY

Our standard tuition fees for EU students for courses starting in 2019 are £8,400 for full-time postgraduate study.

ONLINE LEARNING

Our tuition fees are different for online courses, so please check your course information at go.herts.ac.uk/uhonline-fees

DEPOSIT AND REDUCTION FOR PAYING IN FULL

You'll be required to pay a £5,000 deposit to secure your place with us. If you're able to pay for the whole year in full when you enrol, we'll give you a reduction of £500 for each year.

HOW DO I PAY?

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Every year we offer a limited number of scholarships to international students. These are worth up to £4,000 and are designed to make studying with us more affordable. We also offer graduate scholarships for international students who have already taken an undergraduate degree here and now want to take a Master's course with us. This is the equivalent of a 20% reduction in your tuition fees.

If you're thinking about travelling to the UK for your degree, you might not realise that you can spend part of your course in another country too. It's a great opportunity to make your student experience even more international.

WHERE COULD I GO?

We've more than 160 partner institutions in USA, Canada, Latin America, South Africa, China, Korea, Japan, India, South East Asia and Australia. Subject to the UK remaining part of the Erasmus Programme, which is part of the UK Brexit negotiations, you also have the chance to study at a partner institution in one of around 20 European countries. We're always adding new destinations too.

HOW LONG CAN I STAY?

It depends on your course and where you would like to go. You can study for three months, a semester or a year, and even take a work placement too. We also offer summer schools in Europe and Asia.

VISA INFORMATION

If you're an EU, EEA or Swiss national, you don't need a visa to study in the UK, but if you're from a non-EEA country you do.

TIER 4 GENERAL STUDENT VISA

The Tier 4 visa is part of the UK's visa and immigration points system. For your application to be successful, you'll need to meet the government's immigration rules and achieve 40 points.

You'll be given 30 points for your Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS), which we'll send to you once you've met all the conditions of your offer.

You'll be given another 10 points for maintenance, which means proving you have enough money to pay your fees and living expenses.

WHEN DO I NEED TO APPLY?

If you're applying for a Tier 4 visa, you'll need to do this before you leave your home country. If you're applying for a short-term study visa, you may also need to apply from home, depending where you're from.

The earliest you can apply for either visa is three months before you come to the UK. Don't leave it too late though, it'll usually take at least 15 days to process your application and over the summer (June, July and August) it can take much longer.

If you are offered and accept a place as a student of the University of Hertfordshire, you will become a member of a community which enjoys many rights and privileges. You will also be expected to accept a number of responsibilities in the interests of the community as a whole. These rights and responsibilities form part of the contractual relationship that will exist between us.

Please note that depending on when you visit our website, the displayed version of this document may not necessarily be the version that will apply to you if you are offered and accept a place as a student. The version that will apply to you will be sent to you if we offer you a place.

The following three sections (taken from the 2019–2020 version of the Key Facts document) explain the standards we strive to meet for students accepting an offer of a place for entry in our 2018-2019 academic vear, and the circumstances in which we may make changes to (or occasionally even discontinue) a course before a student finishes.

THE EDUCATION **WE PROVIDE**

supervised, assessed and supported by staff who are appropriately qualified and experienced, taking into account your needs, the needs of other students and the nature of your course. We will use every reasonable effort to provide your educational and other related services in the manner and to the standards set out in our prospectuses, on our website, and in our other published materials. We recognise that you expect to receive the educational service you are paying for. However, we cannot make an absolute commitment to provide our services at all times in this manner and to these standards because, for instance, there may be circumstances outside our reasonable control which have a detrimental effect on how we provide our services to you. These could include, by way of example, industrial action (including by members of our own staff), civil commotion, severe weather conditions. changes in the law and/or actions taken by a government or public authority, damage or destruction to our buildings or facilities. failures by our suppliers or sub-contractors,

Our goal is to ensure that you are taught,

or interruption or failure of utility services. If circumstances such as these arise, we will use every reasonable effort to minimise any disruption to you.

CHANGES TO YOUR COURSE OR MODULES

Although it is never something we do lightly, we may in certain circumstances make changes to the advertised content or structure or methods of delivery of your course or individual modules after you have accepted an offer, which may in certain cases include discontinuing a module. We cannot cover here every possible example of when we might decide to do so, but in normal circumstances it would only be for one or more of the following reasons:

- To reflect changes to the theory in an area of research or practices around the subject or its delivery
- To improve a course or a module (for example, to take account of feedback from students)

- To safeguard academic standards
- To comply with the requirements of an external professional, commissioning or accrediting body (for example, a requirement that certain course content be added, changed or removed or that a particular module is discontinued or included)
- To comply with legal, regulatory or governmental requirements
- Where insufficient students have chosen an optional module, making it unviable, or where a member of staff whose expertise was required to run it is no longer available
- Where the change results from other circumstances outside our reasonable control (for example, an external provider no longer being available to contribute to the course or a module).

If we decide to make a change (other than one which is minor or insignificant) before you have registered on the course for the first time, we will inform you as soon as

reasonably practicable so that you can decide whether or not you still wish to study with us. If as a consequence you decide not to study with us, we will refund any tuition fees and/or deposit that you have paid in advance in respect of the course in question. For further details regarding our refund policy please see our Fees and Finance Policy.

If we decide to make a change (other than one which is minor or insignificant) after you have registered, we will similarly inform you as soon as reasonably practicable, and we will also use every reasonable effort to minimise any adverse effect it may have on you. If in spite of our efforts the change is likely to have a serious adverse effect on you (for example, by prejudicing your future choice of career), we will try to find you a suitable alternative course or module with us or (if you prefer) we will try to suggest a suitable alternative course with another education provider. If you change course or module in these circumstances (or simply withdraw from your course), any entitlement you may have to a refund in tuition fees you have already paid will be determined in accordance with our Fees and Finance Policy.

In the case of a material change to a course or module, we will also in appropriate circumstances try to consult with student representatives with a view to identifying options for, and minimising any adverse effect on, affected students.

Some optional modules may have capacity issues and therefore we may not be able to guarantee you a place on your first choice.
