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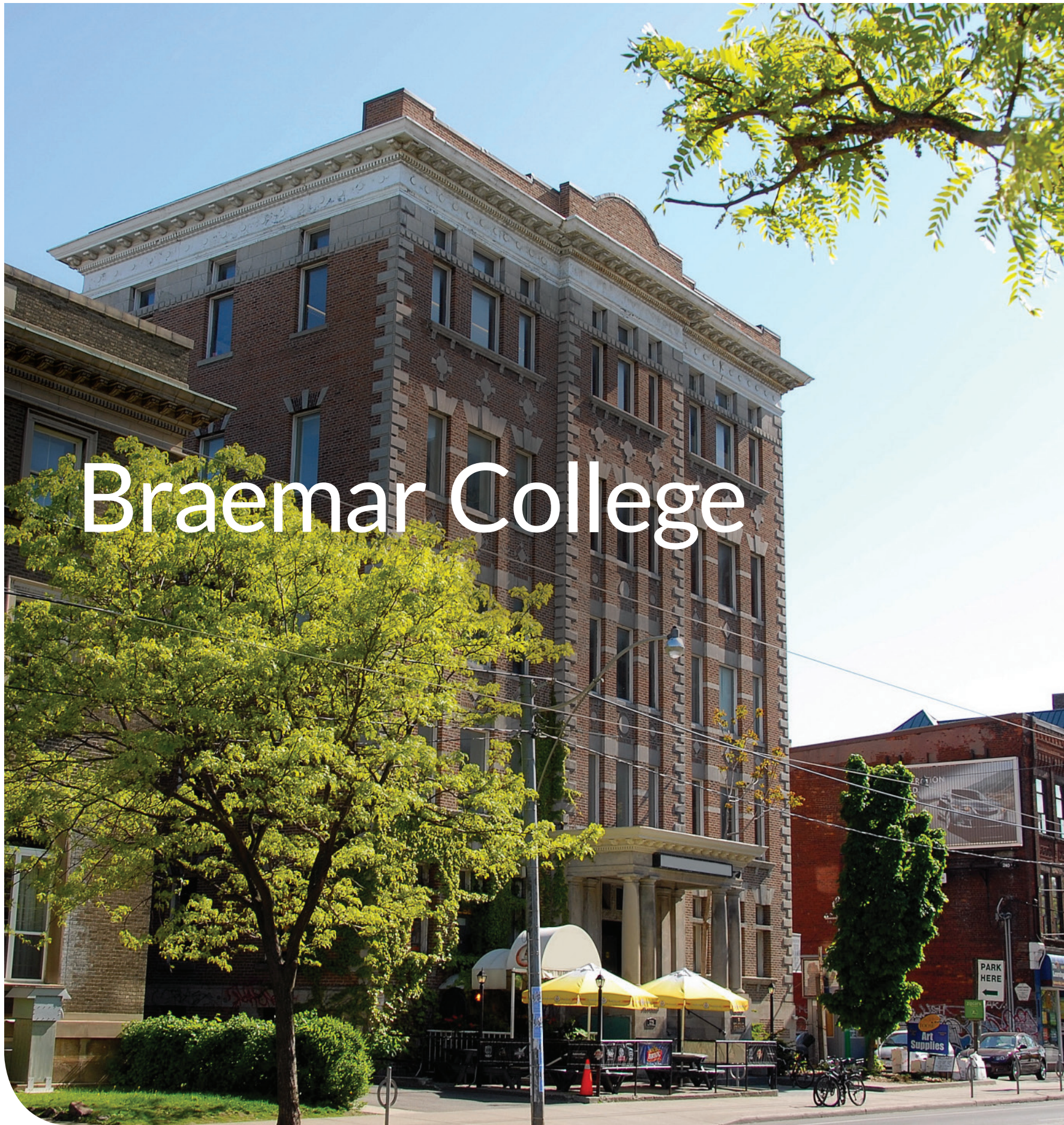
We are a private high school located in downtown Toronto offering grades 9 to 12.

- Accredited by two independent authorities

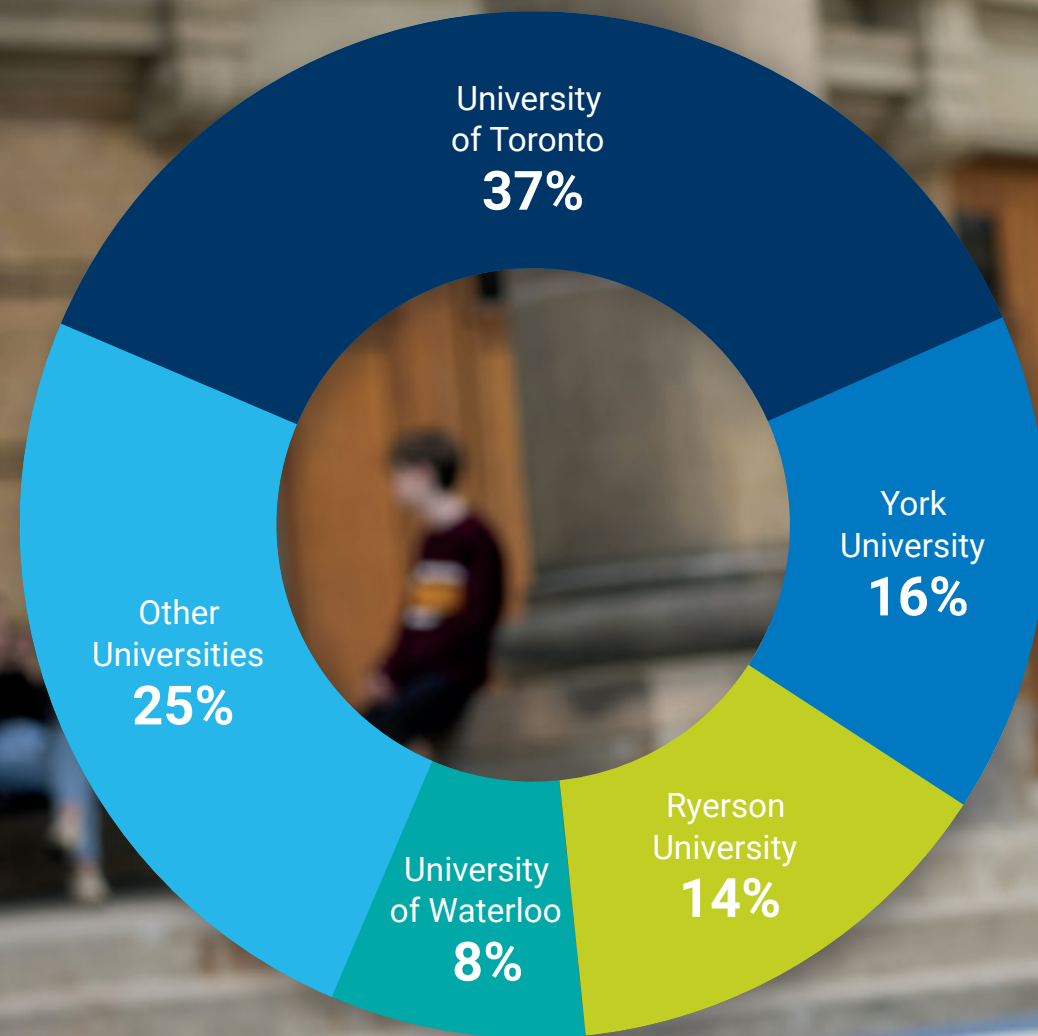

When the study permit is approved the student provides the school with flight information

COMPREHENSIVE TESTING

All students are tested in English and math to ensure they are in the most suitable class.



CREDIT TRANSFER

If you have completed high school work in your home country, the guidance office would grant what are called equivalency credits. Students who have completed grade 11 or higher, and show a high level of ability on the Mathematics and English placement tests, may on that basis receive extra equivalency credits.



PERSONALIZED STUDY PLAN

Drawing on the experience of two decades, our guidance team will draw up a personalized study plan, designed to get you from where you are to where you want to go, giving you, from the very beginning, a clear sense of the big picture.

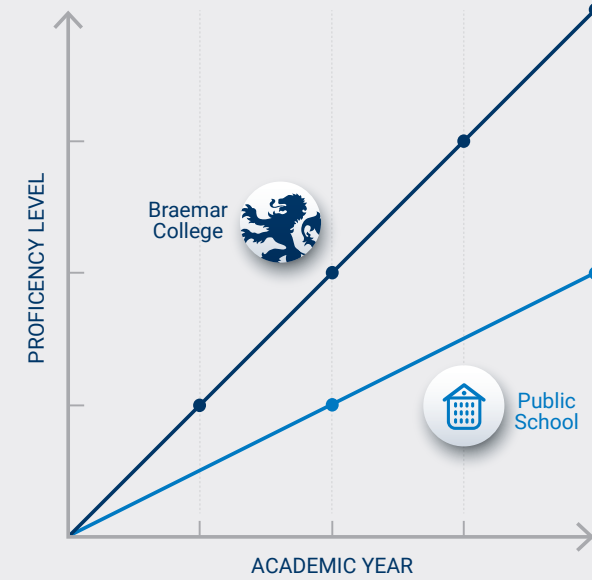

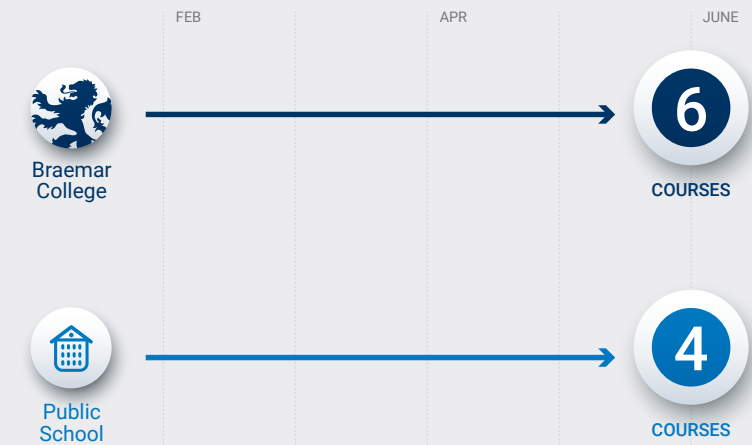

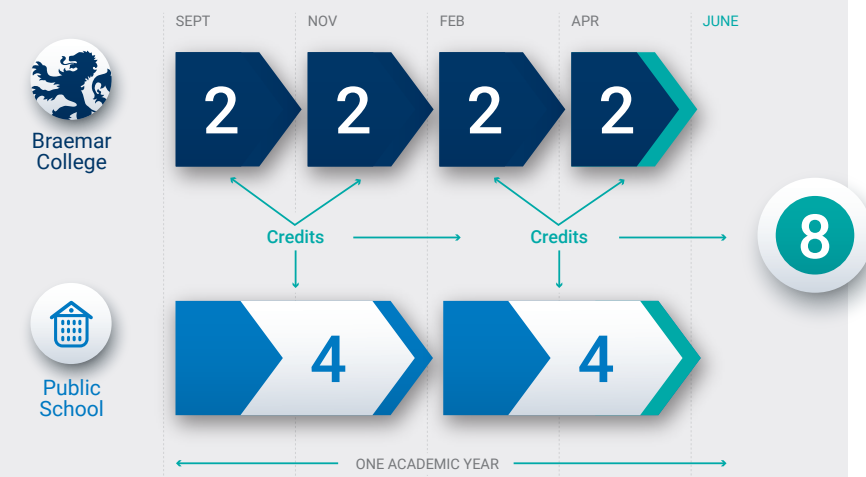
LEARN FASTER: THE EXPRESS OPTION

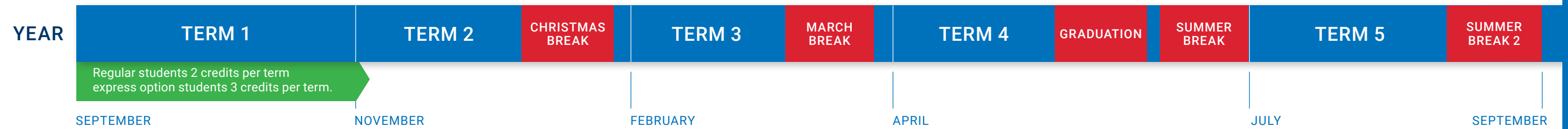
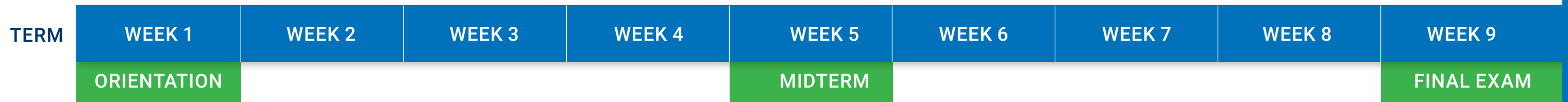
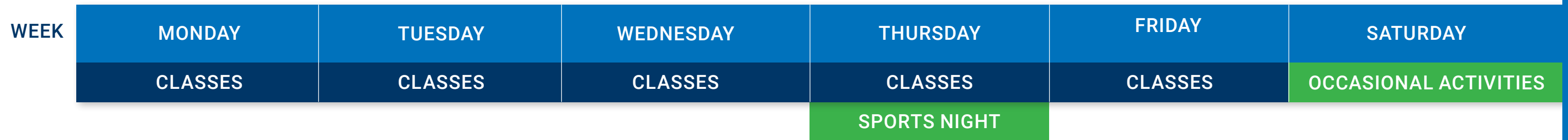
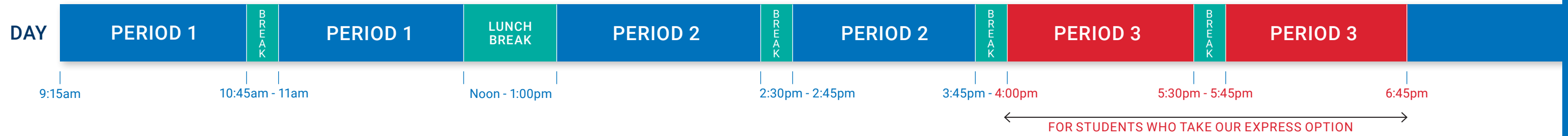


LEARN MORE: THE FAST-TRACK TERM SYSTEM

SUMMER ELITE TEEN PROGRAM

This is non-credit program for international high school students who wish to have a short-term academic high school study experience in Canada.

SUMMER PROGRAM








A program for international high school students who wish to have a short-term academic high school study experience in Canada. Qualified students may receive up to 2 high school credits during the summer school. In addition, students may extend their high school education into the September intake.
