MONEY MATTERS

THERE ARE TWO IMPORTANT OFFICES YOU'LL WANT TO KNOW WHEN IT COMES TO MANAGING THE MONEY INVOLVED WITH ATTAINING YOUR DEGREE.

1. **The Office of Financial Aid** can help you find scholarships, grants, loans and other financial resources to cover your costs. It can answer questions about applying for aid, your financial aid offer and both student and parent loan options.
2. **The Office of Student Billing and Payment** collects tuition, fees, housing and other charges. It can assist you with questions about your balance due, payment plan or payment status.



Bills due: Dec. 16, 2022

BEFORE YOUR FIRST BILL IS DUE ON AUG. 5

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.gov, even if you missed the deadline. It is the best way to maximize the federal, state and university financial aid you receive. Include federal school code 001804, so that UIndy receives your official results. Questions? Call the Office of Financial Aid.
- Use your financial aid offer to help you estimate your balance and decide how to manage it.
- Check your financial aid offer for aid options. Note that some options will require additional action before the aid is applied to your account.
- Accept, decline or modify the loan amounts for Federal Direct Loans (subsidized or unsubsidized).
 - » my.uindy.edu > Self Service > Financial Aid > Award Offer
- Set up your parents or guardians as authorized users with the UIndy bill-payment system at ebill.uindy.edu.
- Review your rights and responsibilities as a consumer of financial aid at uindy.edu/student-consumer-info.
- Check your UIndy bill immediately after you receive it.
 - » See if your non-UIndy scholarships have been applied. Learn more at uindy.edu/outside-scholarships.
 - » Verify your housing and meal plan charges.
 - » Request 529 Plan disbursements, allowing four weeks for checks to arrive.
 - » Pay your bill in full, or sign up for a payment plan to manage your balance.
 - » Check for other ways to manage your balance at uindy.edu/alternative-financing-options.



PAYMENT PLANS

UIndy offers four- or five-month payment plans to manage your payments each semester. Plans do not roll over; you will need to re-enroll for every semester for which you would like a payment plan. To enroll, visit ebill.uindy.edu.

FIRST-SEMESTER PAYMENT PLAN OPTION 1: FIVE-MONTH PLAN

- Enroll between July 6 and July 20.
- Make monthly payments, due July 10 through Nov. 10.
- If you enroll after July 10, your first payment will be due at the time of enrollment.

FIRST-SEMESTER PAYMENT PLAN OPTION 2: FOUR-MONTH PLAN

- Enrollment opens July 21.
- Make monthly payments, due Aug. 10 through Nov. 10.

SECOND-SEMESTER PAYMENT PLANS WILL BE AVAILABLE STARTING IN NOVEMBER.

THREE WAYS TO PAY YOUR BILL

1. Go to ebill.uindy.edu and pay using an electronic check or credit or debit card. A 2.85% convenience fee will be applied to all card transactions.
2. Write a check and send it to the Office of Office of Student Billing & Payment, University of Indianapolis, 1400 E. Hanna Ave., Indianapolis, IN 46227. Include your student ID number on the check.
3. International students, pay using TransferMate. Learn more at uindy.edu/student-billing/internationalpaymentsandtransfermate.

UIndy does not accept cash payments or payments made via phone.

REFUNDS


If you become eligible for a refund for any reason, you will need to be set up with UIndy's refund partner, BankMobile, to receive it. You will receive a green refund-selection kit from BankMobile in July. For more about refunds, visit uindy.edu/student-billing/refunds.

USING THE E-BILL SYSTEM

PARENTS, GUARDIANS AND OTHERS ASSISTING STUDENTS

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA) is a federal law that protects student educational records. Due to FERPA, a student must grant access to their billing information by adding parents, guardians or others as authorized users.

After your student adds you as an authorized user, you will receive two emails from **studentbilling@uindy.edu**. You will need the temporary password from those emails, as well as your email address (the one your student provided when adding you to the system), to gain access to your student's billing account. Go to **ebill.uindy.edu**, select Authorized User Login, and follow the prompts to get started.

STUDENTS

Use the UIndy E-bill Student Account Center to check your balance, view or print your bill, make a payment, add an authorized user or enroll in a payment plan. Go to **ebill.uindy.edu**, select Current Student Login, enter your UIndy username and password, and follow the prompts. The billing website is also available at **my.uindy.edu**.

You must grant access to a parent, guardian or another individual before that person can view, print or pay your UIndy bills. To add an authorized user:

1. Log in to **ebill.uindy.edu**, using your UIndy username and password.
2. Under My Profile, select Authorized Users.
3. Select Add Authorized User.
4. Enter the authorized user's email address.
5. Follow the prompts to complete the enrollment.




