UNDERGRADUATE DEGREES

A full-time undergraduate degree typically spans three years.

Our academic year structure (see pages 18-19) means you will study one module at a time, completing four blocks during the vear.

You will benefit from knowing if you are an AM or PM student from the start of your studies.

Start dates: Sept/Nov/Jan. Course duration: 3 years. Entry criteria: 104 UCAS points or equivalent.*





Upon completion you will receive a Certificate of Higher Education: a level four undergraduate gualification equivalent to the first year of a degree. A student registering for a Certificate of Higher Education can still complete a degree within three years.

Start dates: Sept/Nov/Jan. Course duration: 1 year (part-time available). Entry criteria: 64 UCAS points or equivalent.*



PART-TIME STUDY OPTIONS

Part-time study provides the opportunity for those wanting to return to education or fit a degree around other commitments such as a career. Visit page 43 to view the degree subjects available in this study mode.

You will study on campus on Wednesdays across a four-year period. For information on the academic year structure for part-time study, see pages 24-25.

Start dates: Sept/Jan. Course duration: Cert HE – 16 months. Undergraduate degree – 4 years. Entry criteria: 104 UCAS points or equivalent.*

CERTIFICATE OF HIGHER EDUCATION

Designed for learners who either want to study for a full degree but haven't yet met the entry requirements or do not want to commit to a full degree programme.

You will study at the same pace as a full-time undergraduate degree student. Be sure to view our academic year structure and timetable on pages 18-19 and 20-21.



STEP FORWARD

Step Forward is our free six-week course designed to provide an access route to higher education for those with skills and knowledge gained from their life and work experiences.

The programme will develop your confidence and academic abilities to prepare you for degree-level study.

You'll also benefit from your own personal development tutor throughout. On successful completion you will be eligible to study on a UA92 degree or Certificate of Higher Education course.



ACCELERATED DEGREES

Accelerated degrees at UA92 allow you to study full-time for an undergraduate degree in two years so that you are ready to enter full-time employment sooner.

You will study six blocks each year and have shorter breaks than those on the three-year degree programmes so you can complete your studies in two years. Visit page 72 to view the degree subjects available in this study mode.

STARTING YOUR STUDIES WITH UA92*











ACADEMIC YEAR STRUCTURE

THE KEY DETAILS*

- A full-time academic year, worth 120 credits, is studied over 4 blocks. Each block lasts 6 weeks.
- Assessments are normally contained within each block; there are no traditional end-of-year examination periods outside of the block structure.
- Within one study block, you will complete a single subject module worth 25 credits during weeks 1-5. You'll then study a Target Talent Curriculum module, worth 5 credits, in week 6. This embeds your character and personal development firmly in your chosen subiect area.
- Block 1 starts in September and block 4 finishes in April.
- If you choose to start your studies in November, you will begin in block 2 and finish in block 5. Year two and three of your studies will start in block 1 (September).
- If you choose to start your studies in January, you will begin in block 3 and finish in block 6.
- You can start an accelerated degree in September or January and study all 6 blocks. See pages 22-23 for more information on accelerated degrees' academic year structure.


YOUR WEEKLY

Our straightforward and stable weekly timetable allows you to plan life around your studies.

THE KEY DETAILS*

- Your timetable of compulsory classes will be straightforward. You will either be a 'morning student' in class 9am until 1pm or an 'afternoon student', in class 2pm until 6pm, each weekday (except Wednesdays).
- Your timetable will remain fixed throughout your studies to make it easier to organise your life while you're a student.
- Attending campus on Wednesdays won't be compulsory, but you will have remote and/or online learning activities to engage with fully, as part of your course.
- Wednesdays also provide opportunities to get extra support or do voluntary work, play for one of our sports teams or additional personal development and career enhancement activities.





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



THE KEY DETAILS

- Complete your degree in two years and enter the world of graduate-work much faster. You will study 6 blocks of 6 weeks per year. This is instead of studying 4 blocks of 6 weeks per year, which is how our three-year degree students complete their studies.
- Assessments are normally contained within each block; there are no traditional end-of-year examination periods outside of the block structure.
- Within one study block, you will complete a single subject module worth 25 credits during weeks 1-5. You'll then study a Target Talent Curriculum module, worth 5 credits, in week 6. This embeds your character and personal development firmly in your chosen subject area.
- Block 1 starts in September and block 6 finishes in August.
- If you choose to start your studies in January, you will start in block 3 and finish in block 2.

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THE KEY DETAILS

- Study one day each week on Wednesdays, 9am-6pm at the UA92 campus.
- You will study 3 blocks of 13 weeks per year for four years. This includes a one week break per block. This is instead of studying 4 blocks of 6 weeks per year, which is how our three-year degree students complete their studies.
- Assessments are normally contained within each block; there are no traditional end-of-year examination periods outside of the block structure.
- Within a 13 week block you will study a single subject module worth 25 credits over 11 of the weeks of each block and a single Target Talent Curriculum module worth 5 credits over 2 of the weeks. This embeds your character and personal development firmly in your chosen subject area.
- Block 1 starts in September and block 3 finishes in August.
- If you choose to start your studies in January, you will start in block 2 and finish in block 1.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

If your first language isn't English, you may be asked for a recognised English language qualification. It's important that you can communicate well, verbally and in writing, to make the most of your time here. We look for an IELTS score of 6.0 (with no section lower than 5.5) or equivalent. We also accept a range of English language tests and qualifications which are recognised by the UK Home Office as secure English Language Tests (SELT). CERTIFICATE OF HIGHER EDUCATION

Our Certificate of Higher Education (Cert HE) courses are designed for learners who:

- Want to study for a degree but don't yet hold the entry requirements for a full degree programme, or,
- Do not want to commit to a full degree programme at this point but would like a level 4 gualification equivalent to the first year of a degree.

These courses will allow you to experience university-level study equivalent to the first year of a degree, gaining both subject knowledge and developing personally through our approach to character and personal development and the first four Target Talent Curriculum modules.

Upon successful completion of the course, you can leave with a Certificate of Higher Education. Alternatively, you may wish to apply to progress to the full-time undergraduate degree programme at UA92.

Importantly, a student who begins their studies on a Certificate of Higher Education can still achieve a degree in three years.

FEES, FINANCES AND **PRACTICAL POINTERS**

Choosing to continue your education is an exciting step, and an investment in your future. Though there's help to manage the financial side of things like student loans that you pay back when you're earning - it's a big decision. so here's some help to choose wisely. This might be the first time you've managed your own money, so read on for a clearer picture of how much getting a higher education gualification at UA92 might cost.

HOW MUCH WILL A DEGREE AT UA92 COST?

For home students in 2021/22 the cost of studying a UA92 degree per annum is £9,000 full-time (three years), £6,750 part-time (four years) and £10.800 for accelerated (two years). The cost for international students in 2021/22 is £14,045 per year, and you will be expected to pay 50 percent before your course begins. For information on costs for other study modes, visit UA92.ac.uk/courses

We will announce our fees for 2022 entry online so please check our website for the latest information.

Remember: these fees* only cover the teaching side of things. You'll also need to budget for your accommodation (if you decide to move away from home), trips, travel, and living expenses like IT, sports kit, food and drink, and some money for fun.

ESTIMATED LIVING COSTS

Wondering about the cost of living? It depends on your lifestyle and your budget. but to give you an idea, we've put together an estimate of what UA92 life might look like financially. Here are the typical living costs for a student per week at UA92:

Accommodation	£150-200
Food and toiletries	£30-40
Laundry	£5
Mobile phone	£5-10
Leisure activities	£20

You'll also need to budget for one-off costs like setting up your room with bedding, pots, pans and crockery, clothes, and essentials like insurance and a laptop or tablet. Manchester's a bargain-hunter's paradise though, so if you're thrifty, you can do much of this on a budget.

Most students will choose to take out a student loan to cover the cost of their fees and help with living costs while studying.

HOW TO PAY FOR YOUR DEGREE

You can find out how student loans work in detail at gov.uk/student-finance In line with the government threshold, you will

only repay a student loan after you have left your course and have a job with a salary of more than £26.575 per year.** The student finance website is filled with more details on this.

REDUCING YOUR COSTS

There are lots of ways to make simple savings, like buying only what you need from local markets to reduce your food costs and checking out the charity shops for funky vintage clothes and homeware. You can get active when it comes to transport - it's easy and free to cycle if you bring your bike from home and our student accommodation is within easy walking distance. Socialising needn't be expensive either. Many arts and cultural venues are free to access, while most cinemas, gig venues, theatres, pubs, clubs and restaurants do great student deals to help you stretch your loan too!



HOW DO I APPLY FOR A STUDENT LOAN?

You can apply online at Student Finance England, gov.uk/student-finance

Applying is not dependent on an offer, so you can get a headstart on the process as soon as it opens for applications.

WHEN DO I PAY THIS BACK?

You don't start paying the loan back until vou're working and earning over a set threshold, currently £26.575** - how much you pay depends on your salary.

IS THERE A LOAN FOR LIVING COSTS AND ACCOMMODATION?

Eligible UK students can apply for a Maintenance Loan, again through Student Finance England, up to approximately £8,700 a year for students living away from home to help with the costs of living. Repayment of this works in the same way as your tuition fees - they actually combine together into one sum so it's easy to manage.

We have a Student Support Team on campus who can support you with budgeting and financial advice to help you manage your money while studying with us. What's more, as part of our Target Talent Curriculum, vou'll learn about financial literacy. We also work in partnership with financial education provider, Blackbullion, who provide all our students with access to their great resources.

HELP AVAILABLE?

There are other government grants financial support that you don't have to pay back - these are normally available to help students with disabilities or dependants come to university. You can find out more about what's available and access this support at gov.uk/student-finance

CAN FEES CHANGE OR INCREASE?

We review tuition fees each year. For UK students, if Parliament permits an increase in tuition fees. UA92 – along with other HEIs in England - may increase fees for each subsequent year of study. For international students, UA92 will fix the tuition fee for the duration of your course when studied continuously. 
PLANE


