

International College of Hotel Management (ICHM), Adelaide

ICHM offers two pathways for graduates in Advanced Diploma of Hospitality Management from Salford College. First in Bachelor of Business (Hospitality Management) where they can earn 9 subject credits and would be required to do 15 subjects only.

Second, the Advanced Diploma of Hospitality Management graduates could also enrol in the Pre-Masters semester and the Master of International Hotel Management (Swiss Hotel Association). They would undertake 13 subjects, the combined program is 2.5 years.

 - Main page of your passport (and visa page if onshore)
 - Academic qualifications
 - English language test result (e.g. IELTS, etc.)
 - Proof of Overseas Student Health Cover (If held)
- 4. Please fill our Application Form and GTE Application Form (Off shore Applications) available on our website www.salfordcollege.edu.au along with the enclosed documents mentioned in No. 3 and proof of the Application Fees of \$250 (Cheque/ Netbank) which is non-refundable.
