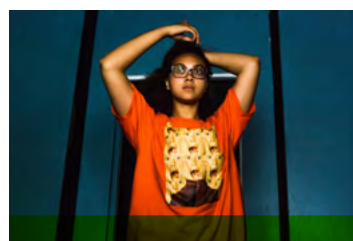

Study alongside UAL undergraduates and fully integrate onto one of our undergraduate BA/BSc courses for a term or academic year.

The Integrated Programme is designed to promote cultural integration into the UK Higher Education system, and students will complete the same schedule and coursework as a Home student. Students should expect independent style learning and an exciting, collaborative environment, where they will regularly undertake discussion-based learning and project work. Applicants should be majoring/minoring in the chosen subject, or have a well-developed portfolio in the subject area.

Optional Modules

We offer 3 week optional modules in European Art History and Creative Industries London. Students do not have to be enrolled in any other Study Abroad programmes to apply. The timing works well with our Integrated Study Abroad programme, either prior to the programme starting or during the Easter break.

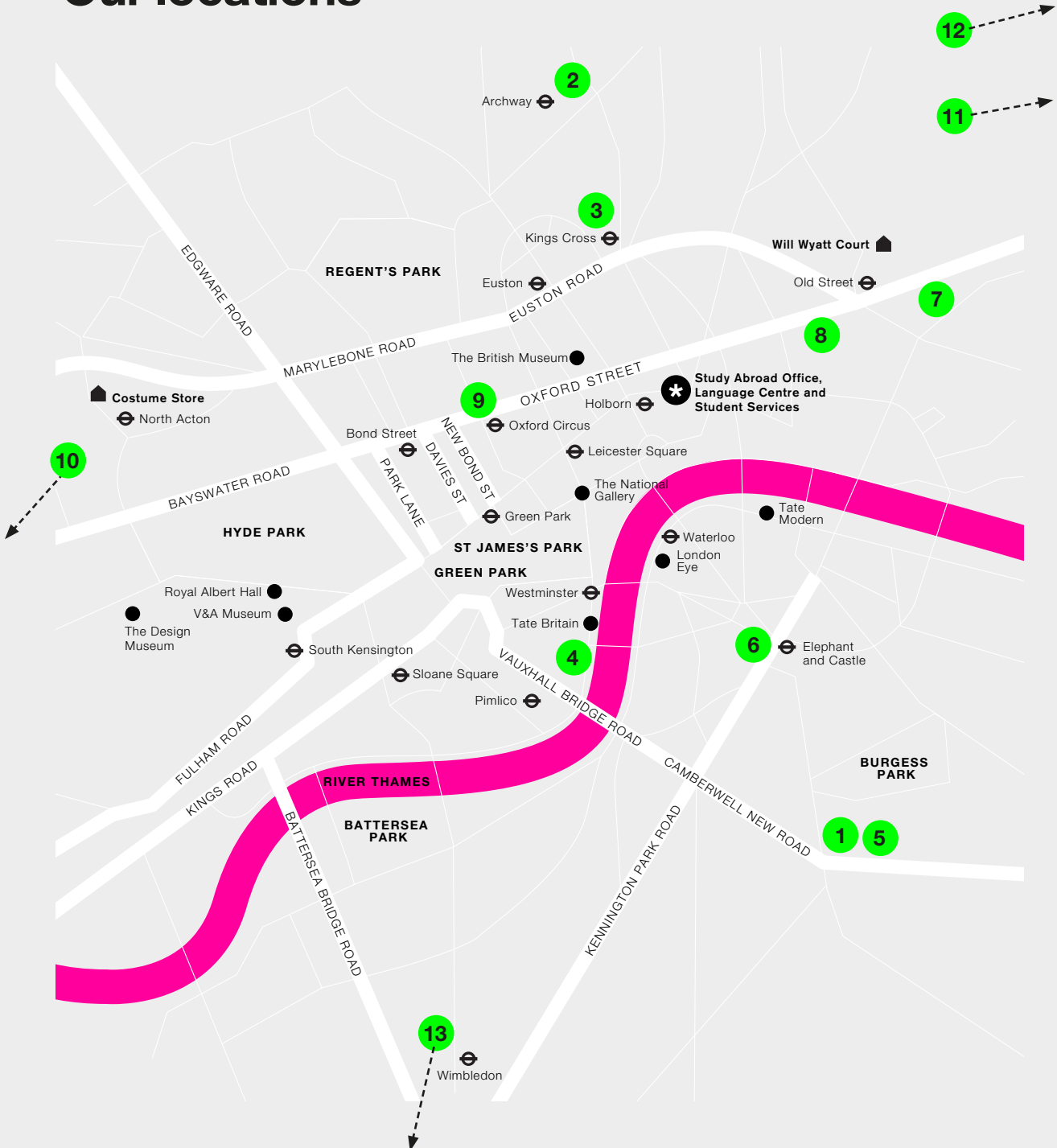
Support & Wellbeing

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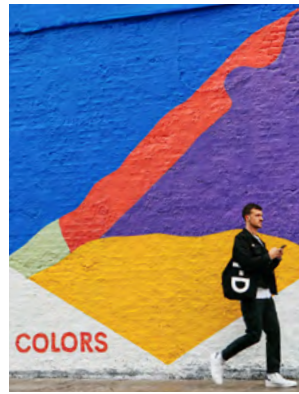
