Reserved for upperclassmen students and coed by room, Methodist Hall provides individual rooms and community living spaces, as well as a kitchenette in each room.



Tuition is based on full time, 12-16 credit hours. Fees are estimated as they vary based on major and required classes. Meal and housing charges vary based on choice.
