

Course Selection & Registration

- Minimum course load = 12 UMN credits
- Maximum course load = 20 UMN credits
- 3000, 4000, 5000 courses are undergraduate courses available to bachelor's and master's exchange students
- 6000+ courses are graduate courses and are available to master's exchange students only

Business and non-business courses are available to exchange students. Students will complete a course preference form before arrival and official registration will take place during the mandatory Welcome Program.

*Please note: The Economics department is not in the Carlson School and registration in those courses are limited.

Arrival & Student Visa
