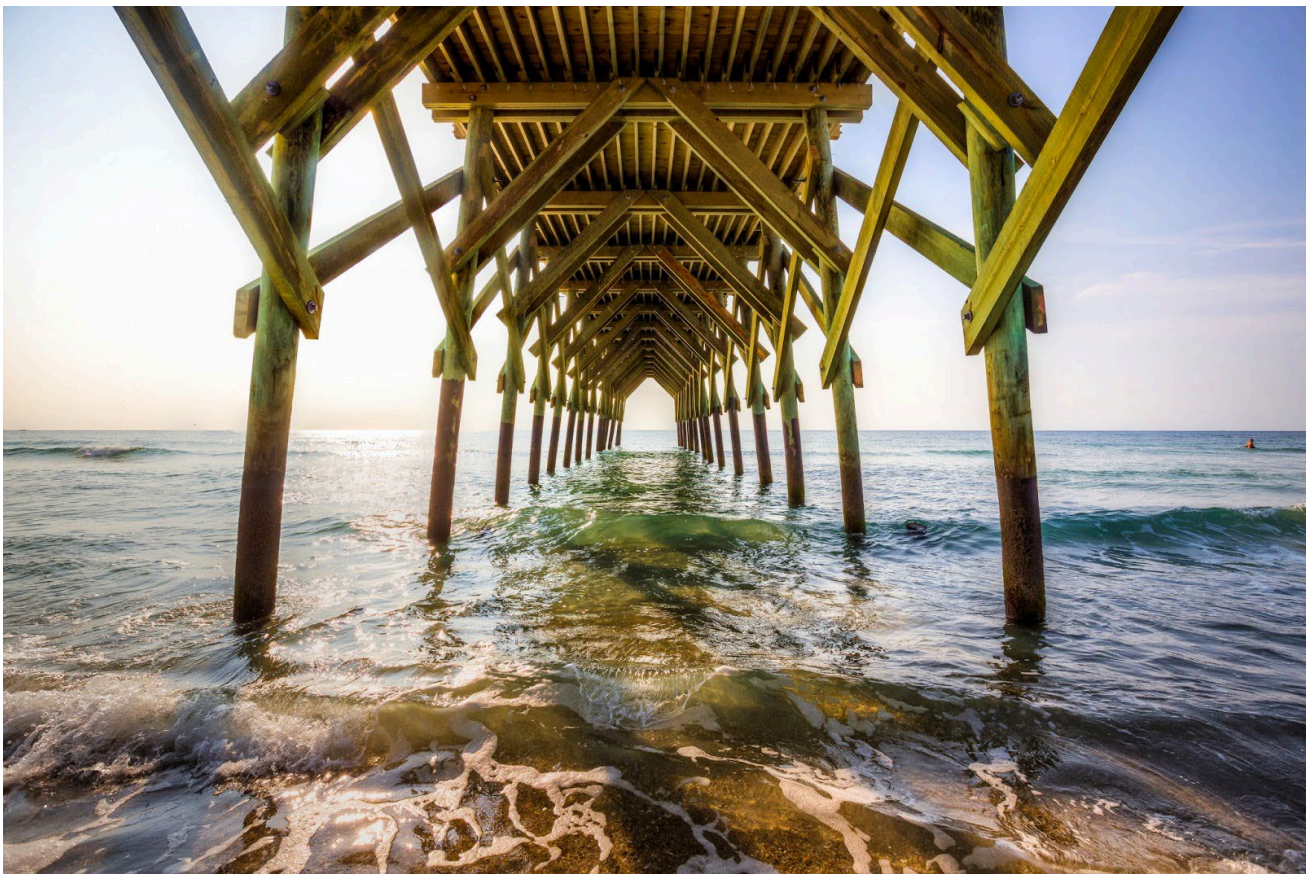

Course Registration	UNCW Course Request Form – During the application process, students will submit their desired courses for the upcoming semester. Students are not guaranteed their top choices.
Courses Offered - by Semester	Important Note: <i>If students submit their requested UNCW courses early, they will have a better chance of getting their preferred UNCW classes.</i>
Course Load per Semester	Important – Most courses in the UNCW catalogue are only offered one semester per academic year. Use the instructions below when selecting your courses: To find course information for the upcoming semester, go to SeaNet (https://seanet.uncw.edu/) , select "Detailed Class Schedule" for their term.
Language of Instruction	Students must take between 12 – 18 UNCW credit hours per semester.

Obtaining U.S. student visa	Once admitted, students will be mailed an acceptance letter along with J1 exchange student immigration document DS-2019. (Students study abroad independently will apply for the F-1 visa) Using the two documents, students will need to complete the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pay the I-901 SEVIS Fee • Locate your nearest U.S. Embassy • Follow the embassy's website instructions for obtaining a Non-Immigrant J1 Exchange Student Visa • Estimate the wait time by selecting your Embassy location on the U.S. Visa Wait Times website
Accommodation	On-Campus Students are guaranteed on-campus housing after they are admitted to UNCW and if they apply by the deadline. Students are emailed instructions upon admission. Off-Campus Exchange students are allowed to live off-campus, but the International Programs Office does not have resources to help students find an off-campus apartment. Students may use the UNCW Off-Campus Housing Service to help locate an apartment.
Airport Shuttle provided	We happily offer a full day of airport shuttle once on-campus housing opens. Once admitted, students will receive the dates/times for the airport shuttle.
Airport location	The local airport is ILM, we will only provide airport shuttle from the ILM airport.
