Entry Requirements

- Pass SPM with at least 3 credits including Mathematics (and pass in English); or
- Pass STPM at least grade C (CGPA 2.0) & credit in Maths, pass in English for SPM; or
- Pass STAM with minimum grade maqbul & credit in Mathematics and pass in English for SPM; or
- Pass certificate (Level 3) in related field & pass SPM with minimum 1 credit in Mathematics & pass English; or
- Other equivalent qualification recognised by the Malaysian Government.
