


Stand out in the professional world with a unique certificate

When you graduate you'll receive much more than an academic transcript. Biomedical and Health Sciences

At the School of Biomedical and Health Sciences you will learn through an innovative educational model that encourages interprofessional education with other healthcare professionals, just like you will in your professional future.

You will get insight into professional practice with clinical internships supervised by active professionals, based on resolving real clinical cases in simulated or virtual reality environments, in pioneering laboratories in Spain equipped with the latest technology developments.

Simulation will also be used as a successful assessment method thanks to the Objective Structured Clinical Assessment (OSCA), where clinical case scenarios are simulated so that the professor can assess your skills in different situations with standard patients.

You'll take another step in your education with internships at leading biohealth institutions and businesses (Internship agreements with Hospital Universitario de Getafe, Infanta Sofía, Grupo Hospitalario Quirón, Hospital Universitario ASI-SA Moncloa, CESIC, ASEBIO, Lilly and Grünenthal Pharma, among others).

The international approach, with a constant influx of students from other countries and the opportunity to study in other languages or spend periods of study at international universities, reinforce your skills and make you a versatile health professional who is better prepared for the global market.

Simulated Hospital

Universidad Europea has a Simulated Hospital where you can gain real clinical practice from the get-go, with the security of working in simulated environments.

The Hospital has an emergency room, intensive care, admissions office, an operating room and a birth simulator. A unique environment that will prepare you to successfully complete your internship with real patients.

Dental Health Clinics

We have three dental health clinics in Madrid and Valencia.

The clinics have cutting-edge facilities equipped with the latest technology such as operating microscopes, Vistascan, CBCT, Intraoral Scanner, Smile Design, etc., as well as all the materials and instruments needed so that students can offer their patients a comprehensive diagnosis and treatment. 
- → Only here can you study subjects dedicated to cross-disciplinary projects and internships every year.

- → You can join over 10 clubs where you can develop products with classmates from different areas: Robotics Club, Air Division, UE Gamestudio, BIM Club, Digital Manufacturing, GraphicaLab, etc.

- → From day one you will have access to facilities equipped with the latest technology, such as a digital manufacturing workshop for architectural models and prototypes using cutting-edge software (FabLab), electronics, mechanical and robotics labs with tools such as MatLab, Ansys, Catia, Rhino, Solidworks, Istram, Sap, Finalcut, etc.
- → You can join a list of students from this school who have received awards for their projects, such as Archiprix.

Students' real projects are recognized by industry professionals.

The Airbus ProtoSpace idea incubator backed a project by Alfonso Parra, an Aerospace Engineering student. After Alsonso completed his internship at Altran, Airbus took note of his project and asked him to join its team.

The Graduation Project by Asen Lyubenov, an Industrial Electronics and Automation Engineering student, took 2nd prize at the best Engineering GP competition of the Autonomous Community of Madrid. His project on improving vehicle ergonomics is based on a 3D steering wheel he designed and printed himself.

The School of Sports and Exercise Sciences opens the doors to research and innovation in the world of sport with its educational model of recognized quality.

Its main characteristics include:

- → You'll receive primarily practical training where you can choose from 11 sporting areas, such as golf, winter sports or outdoor activities that you can only study here.
- → We take the health-related role of the sports and physical therapy professional to the most advanced profiles, thus contributing to successful social and professional progress.
- You'll learn from leading international professionals in the sector who combine teaching with professional and research activities.
- → You'll receive innovative training, with learning based on the case study method, working with professionals from other disciplines, and developing cross-disciplinary skills.

→ Subjects are taught at a **35,000m**² top-level sporting facility and in the most advanced laboratories.

In 2017, a team of Universidad Europea professors and students analyzed the economic impact of the previous year's Mutua Madrid Open tennis tournament.

The analysis, led by professors from Universidad Europea and the Real Madrid – Universidad Europea Graduate School, included **the collaboration of 6 professors and 46 students** of Sports Management, Sports Science, and Sports Science and Physical Therapy, who will also analyze the impact in 2017. In addition to these figures, the study extracted data on the impact of average spending per spectator (€298.84), generating jobs and social impact (3,713 direct and indirect jobs) and state income (€17.45 million).






