FAST FACTS

The Intensive English Language Program (IELP) is designed for international students who would like to enter degree programs at Manhattan College, but do not yet have the English proficiency scores to do so.

Some advantages of studying at the IELP are:

- Conditional Admission for seamless entry into College degree programs;
- Opportunity to improve English language skills at a cozy campus setting in New York City;
- Exposure to American college classroom teaching;
- Small class sizes, typically 12 students or fewer;
- A great first step into Manhattan College life.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

The IELP offers six levels of English courses for students of all levels. Each level is one IELP session in length. Students receive a pass/fail mark at the end of each level. Students are placed in levels either using their TOEFL/IELTS/PTE scores or by their IELP placement examination score.

ADMISSION AND VISA INFORMATION

Students who have completed high school are eligible for entry into the IELP. Students who meet all requirements for undergraduate admission except English proficiency are eligible for Conditional Admission. Students who receive IELP admission will be issued form I-20 for an F-1 visa. Students who successfully meet English proficiency requirements after attending the IELP will be admitted to a degree program if all other admission requirements are satisfied.
