01. ielts/toefl exemption

Upon arrival, students who do not have a sufficient IELTS/TOEFL score will be given a placement test to determine their English level. Qualified students are eligible to transfer to our partnering universities.

03. PGSA PROGRAM FOR POST-GRADUATE STUDENTS

Students who successfully complete Dorset's PGSA program can transfer to the Master of Business Administration Program at Cape Breton University or Trinity Western University.

O 5 • WORK PERMIT UPON GRADUATION

Dorset students who complete a diploma/degree at our partnering universities are eligible for a post-graduation work permit for up to 3 years.

02. UNIQUE UNIVERSITY TRANSFER (DIPLOMA) PROGRAM

Upon successful completion of the diploma program at Dorset, students can transfer to one of Dorset's partnering universities which are highly ranked by Maclean's Magazine and the Globe and Mail to complete their Bachelor's or Master's Degree.

04. TRIMESTER SYSTEM

Since Dorset has 3 intakes (January, May and September) every year, students will be able to study 3 semesters a year and reduce the length of time to graduate.

06. SMALL CLASSROOM SIZES

The amount of students ranges from 10-20 per classroom. We ensure individual attention as much as possible.



Business Studies

The degree is designed to build a strong foundation in business fundamentals and then go on to develop specialized knowledge and skills in your major area of study. The degree also develops the student's practical managerial skills, communication skills and business decision-making capability.



The Dorset College transfer program in business studies is a one year degree programs. Students who successfully complete the 30 credits program requirement with sufficient GPA will be eligible to transfer to second year of our partnering college.

After completion of the 2 year Diploma in Business Administration in our partnering college, student may apply to Bachelor degree studies at The University of British Columbia (UBC), Simon Fraser University (SFU), and University of Victoria (UVIC) by satisfying the receiving institutions' requirements.



- Completion of a certificate or equivalent from a special needs program and has been in school for 12 years

02. LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENT

ALL APPLICANTS TO THE COLLEGE MUST DEMONSTRATE PROFICIENCY IN ENGLISH BY PROVIDING PROOF OF **ONE** OF THE FOLLOWING:

- English 12 minimum final grade of 50%
- Communications 12 minimum final grade of 67%
- International Baccalaureate (IB) English Language A (Higher Level) minimum mark of 5
- IELTS Minimum overall ban test score of 6.0 overall with no band test score below 5.5
- TOEFL Minimum score 80 (Internet based), or Minimum score 213 (Computer based), or Minimum score 550 (Paper based)
- LPI Minimum score of 4

- 1. Demonstrate sufficient proficiency in English on the Dorset English Proficiency Exam (50%), or
- 2. Successfully complete the Dorset Academic Preparation program with a grade average of 65%.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Complete the Dorset College application form and submit the following required documents:
 - A non-refundable application fee of CAD\$200.00
 - Certified copies of transcripts and diploma/degree
 - Two photographs of at least 35mm x 45mm in size
 - TOEFL score or other English Language test scores, if available
 - Other additional entrance documentation required for your desired program (Please check the program brochures or online at www.dorsetcollege.bc.ca for more details.)
- Mail or Submit this application in-person, along with your supporting documents to Dorset College.
- 3. If your application is approved, you will receive a letter from Dorset and be asked to prepay the required tuition fees.
- 4. Upon receipt of the required tuition fees, you will receive a Letter of Acceptance and a tuition receipt confirming your acceptance into the College.
- 5. If you are an International Student, the Letter of Acceptance is required when applying to the Canadian Embassy or High Commission for a Study Permit and/or entry visa into Canada.
- 6. Once you have received authorization to study in Canada, you should make the necessary travel and accommodation arrangements. If you would like to take advantage of our homestay and airport pick-up service, please inform the College at least two weeks in advance. Report to Dorset College on the assigned registration dates with the documents mentioned in your Letter of Acceptance.

Note: Applications received without the application fee will not be processed
